### **How to Study the Bible for Application**

The Significance of Applied Truth: *(James 1:22-25; Matthew 22:29)*

The Bible is God's Word: *(2 Peter 1:20-21)*

God's Word is Applicable for All Things: *(2 Timothy 3:16-17; Acts 17:11; Philippians 2:14; 2 Cor. 9:8; 1 Peter 3:3-4)*

Daniel, Chapter One: Introduction to Daniel

Daniel 1:1-2 God Disciplines His People (*theme*)

*Questions to consider for application:* Do I heed God's warning to turn from sin? If I truly believe God would keep His Word, would I continue to disobey Him?

*Statements to consider for application:* God will allow me to eventually suffer the consequences of my choices. God will allow us to live in exile to fulfill His purpose. Heeding God's warnings will keep me from experiencing undesired consequences.

Daniel 1:3-7 Daniel's Life Changes (*theme*)

*Questions to consider for application:* Can I trust God's purpose even when I suffer because of other people's choices? What is my response when I find myself in an ungodly environment?

*Statements to consider for application:* In one day, Daniel's life changed. I should hold my life loosely; trusting God is in control. God created me specifically with attributes that fulfill His purposes!

Application via Subject: *(Philippians 2:14)*

Four questions to ask for proper application:

Two questions to ask when the question is not a godly attribute:
